<b>Summary:</b>	The papers of sculptor, painter, and gallery owner Bardene Allen measure 0.8 linear feet and date from 1965-2014. Allen's career as a painter and sculptor, her friendship with Frederick Hammersley, and her administration of the Fine Arts Gallery in Laguna Beach, California, are documented through biographical material, correspondence, professional files, exhibition files, photographic materials including digital photographs, and printed material.

### Acquisition Information

The papers were donated from 1992 to 2002, 2009, and 2014 by Bardene Allen.

### Available Formats

The bulk of the collection was digitized in 2022 and is available on the Archives of American Art website. Items not digitized include blank versos of photographs, and the full text of exhibition catalogs and a directory for which only front covers, title pages, and other relevant pages have been digitized.

Access copies of born-digital records are not online and are available at the Archives of American Art offices.

### Processing Information

The collection was processed and a finding aid prepared by Ryan Evans in 2019. The collection was prepared for digitization and the finding aid was revised by Stephanie Ashley in 2021. The collection was digitized in 2022 with funding provided by the Frederick Hammersley Foundation.

## Terms of Use

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## Biographical / Historical

Bardene Allen (1933- ) is a sculptor, painter and former gallery owner in Laguna Beach, California. Allen received her Bachelor of Fine Arts degree at Pomona College in 1955 where she studied under Frederick Hammersley, who would become a life-long friend and correspondent. She is the former owner of the Fine Arts Gallery in Laguna Beach, California which was in operation from 1980 to 1983. As a sculptor Allen has worked in stone, wood, resin, bronze and terracotta. Her subjects in sculpture and painting range from mythic gods and imaginary creatures to everyday characters, Hollywood entertainers, and popular musicians in rock and jazz music.

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## Scope and Contents

The papers of sculptor, painter, and gallery owner Bardene Allen measure 0.8 linear feet and date from 1965-2014. Allen's career as a painter and sculptor, her friendship with Frederick Hammersley, and her administration of the Fine Arts Gallery in Laguna Beach, California, are documented through biographical material, correspondence, professional files, exhibition files, photographic materials including digital photographs, and printed material.

Correspondence includes a small amount of professional correspondence regarding Allen's career. Also of note is personal correspondence which includes letters from Frederick Hammersley and actor Richard Chamberlain. Professional files include a statement of Allen's thoughts on her relationship with Frederick Hammersley, as well as price lists, artwork inventories, donations, commission proposals, and documentation of her involvement with both the Fine Arts Gallery in Laguna Beach, California and the Orange County Center for Contemporary Art. Exhibition files are for select exhibitions Allen participated in. Photographic material includes printed photographs and transparencies as well as digitized and digital images of artwork and of Allen with her artwork and at exhibitions. Printed material includes press clippings and exhibition invitations and catalogs.

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## Series 2: Correspondence, circa 1965-2009

### 0.2 Linear feet (Box 1)

**Scope and Contents:** Correspondence includes one folder of general personal correspondence, correspondence with friend and actor Richard Chamberlain, and letters and cards from Allen's former professor and friend Frederick Hammersley. Additionally, there are two folders of professional correspondence relating to Allen's career.

Included are three letters and two cards from Richard Chamberlain, who writes of his excitement about his upcoming role in the television adaptation of *Shogun*.

The Hammersley material is all in the form of letters and postcards from Hammersley and one letter from Hammersley's sister enclosing his obituary. Many of the letters include photos of exhibitions and artwork, some picturing Hammersley, clippings of cartoons, and clippings of articles about Hammersley. Also found in Hammersley's letters are copies of scattered family photos taken by Harold Hammersley.

Professional correspondence is with galleries, including El Prado Galleries and Laguna Beach Arts Commission, and others to whom Allen sent her work on consignment. Also found are three items of correspondence with Karl Benjamin.

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## Series 3: Professional Files, circa 1980-1994

### 0.1 Linear feet

**Scope and Contents:** Series includes scattered documentation of Allen's professional activities including records of a donation Allen made to an art auction, retail price lists for her sculpture from 1988-1992, inventories of artwork, and commission proposals. Documentation of Allen's involvement with the Fine Arts Gallery in Laguna Beach, California is in the form of lists and notes on artists who exhibited there. Her involvement with the Orange County Center for Contemporary Art, for which Allen was the director from 1988-1990, is primarily in the form of printed material.

Also of note is a copy of a letter to Margaret Kuntz describing her friendship with Frederick Hammersley, and a copy of a letter to Hammersley which enclosed her letter to Kuntz. Allen sent the letter to Kuntz for a book Kuntz was writing on Southern California artists.
