## Biographical / Historical

Anna Muirson Johnson Bellamy (1839-1922) was the sister of artist Katharine Livingston Bayard Johnson and mathematician William Woolsey Johnson (1841-1927).

Katharine Livingston Bayard Johnson (1845-1906) was a painter in Paris, France. Born in the Massachusetts, Johnson lived in Europe for most of her life.

## Scope and Contents

The microfilmed Johnson family letters contain letters to Anna Muirson Bellamy from her sister, Katharine Livingston Bayard Johnson, a Boston-born painter who long resided in France. Also included is one letter from Bellamy's brother, William Woolsey Johnson, a mathematician and textbook author.
