Biographical / Historical

Arabella Chandler McClintock Bellamy (1878-1962) was a textile designer in Massachusetts and worked as a designer and, later, quality control agent, for Coheco Manufacturing Company. She married Robert B. Bellamy, the son of Anna M. Johnson Bellamy and nephew of painter Katharine Livingston Bayard Johnson.
