Biographical / Historical

Rosalind Bengelsdorf Browne (1916-1979) was a painter, art critic and teacher in New York, New York. She was a member of the New York Art Students' League and the American Abstract Artists.

Scope and Contents

An interview of Rosalind Bengelsdorf Browne conducted 1968 January 29-February 16, by Irving Sandler, for the Archives of American Art. Bengelsdorf Browne discusses her association with the American Abstract Artists group during the 1930s, 1940s, and 1950s. She speaks at length of her late husband, Byron Browne, and her associations

with artists including Arshile Gorky and Willem de Kooning, among others. She reads excerpts from her speeches to artist groups.
