Carin Drechsler-Marx (1939- ) is a photographer based in New York, New York. Drechsler-Marx emigrated from Germany to the United States in 1960 and attended the School of Visual Arts in New York.

The records include commission contract with Rene Block for photo documentation of SoHo, correspondence and exhibition printed materials in German, newspaper press clippings, note and hand-drawn SoHo map with artists' studios, and photographs, slides, and negatives Drechsler-Marx took of SoHo galleries, artists' lofts, and general SoHo streets.

Galleries documented include A.I.R. Gallery, Andre Emmerich Gallery, Castelli Gallery, Holly Solomon Gallery, John Gibson Gallery, John Weber Gallery, O.K. Harris Gallery, Paula Cooper Gallery, and Sonnabend Gallery, among others. Artists' lofts include those of Camille Billops, Christo, Shigeko Kubota, Robert Kushner, Miriam Shapiro, Nora Speyer and Sideo Fromboluti, and Hannah Wilke, among others.
