Biographical / Historical

Norman Albert Geske (1915-) was a museum director and educator. Easton Pribble is a painter, and art instructor.

Scope and Contents

Pribble initially requests a recommendation from Geske for a Huntington Hartford Foundation fellowship, to which Geske responds favorably, though requiring additional information. In the final letter Pribble relates that he has rethought the entire matter because of the antipathy recently expressed by Huntington Hartford towards modern artists.
