Biographical / Historical

Barbara Whipple Heilman, known professionally as Barbara Whipple, curated a Luigi Rist exhibition at the Community Art Gallery of Lancaster County, Franklin and Marshall College, Penn. in 1970. Rist is best known as a printmaker, who studied Japanese techniques. He lived most of his life in Newark, New Jersey.

Scope and Contents

A published biographical essay on Rist by Heilman; an article on Rist attributed to Morris Blackburn; lists of Rist's drawings; articles about him; photographs of his work and the plan of an exhibition installation at the Community Art Gallery of Lancaster County.
