**Summary:** The papers of Elizabeth Basye Gilmore Holt measure 13.1 linear feet and

date from 1923 to 1987. The papers document Holt's career as an art historian, educator, and author based in Washington, D.C., and Georgetown, Maine, through biographical material; correspondences with friends,

colleagues, and publishers; writings in the form of one diary and notes, lectures, and essays; extensive project files related to her various books as well as several film projects; printed material such as clippings, brochures, and reference material; and photographic materials that largely consist of

lecture slides.

The Elizabeth Basye Gilmore Holt papers were donated to the Archives of American Art in several installments from 1988 to 1991 by Holt's daughter, Elizabeth Holt Muench, and her brother, John A. Gilmore.

Also found in the Archives of American Art is an oral history interview with Elizabeth Basye Gilmore Holt conducted by Josephine Withers in 1978.

#### Available Formats

Only one folder of material about Elizabeth Holt's work for the Works Progress Administration is available on 35mm microfilm reel 2814 at Archives of American Art offices and through interlibrary loan. The rest of the collection is not microfilmed.

#### Processing Information

The collection received a preliminary level of arrangement by Jean Fitzgerald after donation in the late 1980s to early 1990s and one folder was microfilmed on reel 2814. Multiple accessions were merged and a finding aid prepared by Rihoko Ueno in 2023.

### **Biographical / Historical**

Elizabeth Basye Gilmore Holt (1905-1987) was an art historian, educator, and author largely based in Washington, D.C. and Georgetown, Maine. She earned her undergraduate degree from the University of Wisconsin (1929), a master's degree from Radcliffe College (1932), and her doctoral degree at the University of Munich (1934). From 1935-1936 she worked as a technical supervisor for the Works Progress Administration's Federal Arts Project and opened a community art center in Raleigh, North Carolina. Holt taught at Duke University, Michigan State University of East Lansing, Boston University, and other universities over the course of her career.

### **Scope and Contents**

The papers of Elizabeth Basye Gilmore Holt measure 13.1 linear feet and date from 1923 to 1987. The papers document Holt's career as an art historian, educator, and author based in Washington, D.C., and Georgetown, Maine, through biographical material; correspondences with friends, colleagues, and publishers; writings in the form of one diary and notes, lectures, and essays; extensive project files related to her various books as well as several film projects; printed material such as clippings, brochures, and reference material; and photographic materials that largely consist of lecture slides.

# Scope and Contents:

Project files form the bulk of the collection and relate to Holt's books as well as a few film projects she worked on. There are notes, drafts of manuscripts, photographs, and printed material relating to the publications, *Documentary History of Art* (Vol. 3); *Sinner, Will You Come to the Highlands of Heaven?"* (1975); *Hymns on Stone: Lithographs of the Jacksonian Era* (1946); *The Triumph of Art for the Public* (1968-1969); *Pictures to Serve the People* (1971-1975); *The Art of All Nations* (1974-1978); and *The Expanding World of Art* (1966-1986).

There are also notes and printed material relating to proposed films *John Brown: A Conscience Aroused* (1974-1979), *Early Art Along the Ohio* (1975), and *The Life of Isaiah Thomas* (1977).

There is also one folder of correspondence and reports concerning WPA-FAP aid for North Carolina artists.
