The papers of photographer Steve Kahn measure 9.4 linear feet and date from 1943-2018. The collection contains biographical material; personal writings by Kahn; personal and professional correspondence; photographs, slides and negatives of works of art and personal photographs of Kahn playing the flamenco guitar, family, friends and colleagues; and printed material relating to Kahn's exhibitions. A portion of the collection contains electronic media.
