Elizabeth (Betty) Beebe Klavun (1914-1986) was a painter and sculptor in New York City, New York. Klavun began her career as an artist later in life and often exhibited at the Bertha Schaefer Gallery.

The papers of painter and sculptor Elizabeth (Betty) Klavun measure 0.3 linear feet and date from 1952 to 1975. Found are artworks, biographical material, correspondence, photographs of Klavun, exhibitions, and works of art, and printed material.

Scope and Contents:

Series includes two painted sketches and one pen sketch of abstract designs and a landscape. Biographical materials include resumes and bookplates designed by Klavun. Correspondence is with the Federation of Modern Painters and Sculptors, Jacob Javits, and the New York Studio School and includes a mix of personal and professional correspondence. Photographs depict Klavun with her work and Klavun's home on Commerce Street in New York City; exhibitions at Bertha Schaefer Gallery; and works of art. Printed materials concern Klavun's career and include clippings and exhibition announcements and catalogs.
