Kent Kleinman (1956-) is an author, dean of Cornell University's College of Architecture and a former professor at State University of New York, Buffalo, New York and University of Michigan. Rudolf Arnheim (1904-2007) was an art historian, educator, writer and psychologist, who taught at Harvard and at the University of Michigan.
