David Levinthal (1949-) is a photographer in New York City known for his innovative use of toys, stark lighting, and miniature environments to examine American socio-political dynamics.

Scope and Contents

The David Levinthal papers measure 13.4 linear feet and date from 1967-2015. included are 4x 5 Polaroid photographs, digital pigment prints and contact sheets for various artwork series; biographical material including resumes; project, research and exhibition files; teaching material; printed material; and 12 journals and other writings by Levinthal documenting his personal and professional life.
