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Biographical / Historical

Maxwell Galleries, Ltd. was started in San Francisco, California in 1940 by Fred Maxwell. The gallery specialized in 19th and 20th century American and European paintings as well as early California art. In 1973, Maxwell's nephew, Mark Hoffman, and his wife, Colleen, inherited Maxwell Galleries.

Scope and Contents

The Maxwell Galleries records measure 0.6 linear feet and date from 1943 to 1970. The collection contains exhibition announcements, catalogs, a membership card, and newspaper clippings, most of which are advertisements for exhibitions at Maxwell Galleries. The collection includes two scrapbooks, one is comprised of clippings and the other contains photographs from exhibitions, invitations, catalogs, and newspaper clippings. Also found here is one copy of *Jackson Pollock: Psychoanalytic Drawings*, by C. L. Wysuph. Wysuph dedicated the book to Fred Maxwell.
