Records consist of 18 transcripts of the radio program's weekly discussions between Fernando Puma and Helen Waren broadcast from October 1, 1943 to February 18, 1944.

## **Biographical / Historical**

*The Artist Reviews Art* was a radio show broadcast on WEVD and WABF, New York, hosted by Fernando Puma (1915-1955) and Helen Waren. Puma is identified in the broadcast introductions as a "prominent modern artist and gallery owner," and Waren is identified as an "actress and art lover." The transcripts document their weekly discussions of current art exhibitions in galleries and museums between February 1943 and October 1944.

## **Scope and Contents**

The records of WEVD and WABF, New York, radio program *The Artist Reviews Art* measure 0.01 linear feet and date from 1943-1944. Records consist of 18 transcripts of the radio program's weekly discussions between Fernando Puma and Helen Waren broadcast from October 1, 1943 to February 18, 1944.
