2.4 linear feet and document the lives and work of the painters through biographical material, correspondence, writings, artworks and sketchbooks, personal business records, printed materials, photographic materials, and video recordings. Material related to the Speyer family, including sculptor Tillie Speyer, Paris gallerist Darthea Speyer, museum curator A. James Speyer, the Speyer family art collection, as well as material related to

mosaicist Omero Fromboluti, are also found.

Biographical / Historical

Nora Speyer (1923-2024) and Sideo Fromboluti (1921-2014) were painters active in New York City and Wellfleet, Massachusetts, and two of the founding members of Long Point Gallery in Provincetown, Massachusetts.

Nora Speyer was born in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania and attended Tyler College of Art in Philadelphia, where she met her husband, Sideo Fromboluti. Sideo was born in Hershey, Pennsylvania, and was drafted to serve in WWII and completed service Kansas. They married in 1944 and moved to the East Village in New York City in 1948. Both were involved in the 10th Street art scene and the Abstract Expressionist movement. Both had solo and group shows around the New York galleries, including the Tanager, Stable, and Poindexter galleries, and showed regularly at the Galerie Darthea Speyer in Paris, France. They were founding members of the Landmark Gallery in SoHo, as well as Long Point Gallery in Provincetown, Massachusetts.

Scope and Contents

The Nora Speyer and Sideo Fromboluti papers, 1927-2015, measure 2.4 linear feet and document the lives and work of the painters through biographical material, correspondence, writings, artworks and sketchbooks, personal business records, printed materials, photographic materials, and video recordings. Material related to the Speyer family, including sculptor Tillie Speyer, Paris gallerist Darthea Speyer, museum curator A. James Speyer, the Speyer family art collection, as well as material related to mosaicist Omero Fromboluti, are also found.
