Jerry L. Thompson (1945-) is a professional photographer in New York, New York who photographed works of art and artists for many museums, artists, galleries, and foundations. Thompson served as photographer in residence in the American Wing of the Metropolitan Museum from 1983-84 and was an instructor and assistant professor at Yale University from 1973-80.

# **Scope and Contents**

The papers of photographer Jerry L. Thompson measure 5.8 linear feet and date from 1970-2016, Included are color transparencies (mostly 8  $\times$  10 and 4  $\times$  5), black and white and color photographs, negatives and digital images of works of art and of artists by Jerry L. Thompson. Also included is small amount of correspondence and printed material.
