Scope and Contents:

Two letters are to Margaret Christie and Marion Weeks concerning the publishing of Weeks's work and research. An exhibition catalog is from a 1963 display entitled *Royal Children* at Buckingham Palace. A draft of Weeks's works *The Bourbon Inheritance: a Study in Heredity* and *The Royal Children of England and France: a Study in Heredity* by Marion Weeks include typed and handwritten narratives and notes, reproductions of works of art, and clippings. The works focus on the facial features and hereditary traits of the descendants of English and French monarchs through generations. Also found are scattered research materials including clippings and reproductions of works of art.
