Description

Each page of engravings is counted as one item. When there are multiple engravings on a page, this is indicated in a note under the item listing. When known, the publisher, author, and citation are provided.

When there are engravings on both sides of a page, the pages are differentiated with sides A and B.

All information not in brackets and/or in quotes are original titles; words in brackets were provided by the archivist.

Dimensions are given in height by width. When there are multiple engravings on one page, the measurement of the entire page is given; each engraving is not measured distinctly. However,

when there is only one engraving on a page, the specific measurement of that engraving is provided.

Scope and Contents

The Historic Engravings collection consists of 154 pages of engravings, dating from 1747 to circa 1905, with the bulk created in the second half of the nineteenth century. Many of the engravings were completed for publication in leading nineteenth-century newspapers, including the *Illustrated London News* and *Harper's Weekly*.

Numerous engravings depict scenes from expeditions, including the Dr. Livingstone (Central and South Africa), Baker (Central Africa), and Stanley expeditions. Topics illustrated include agriculture, ceremonies, city and town views, ships, animals, battles, domestic scenes, diamond mines, and fashions. Represented peoples include the Khoikoi, Abyssinian, Ashanti, Griquas, Khoikoi, Ndebele, and Zulu. Finally, the engravings depict such wide-ranging locations as Abyssinia, Annesley Bay, Chupanga, Dahomey, Gondokoro, Hadoda Pass, Hamhamo Spring, Keiskamma Gorge, Mount Kilimanjaro, Kongone River, Lake Tanganyika, Limpopo River, Matabili [now Zimbabwe], Morocco, Nigeria, the Red Sea, Sierra Leone, Somalia, South Africa, Tekonda Pass, Ujiji, Umizinkulu Waterfall, Zambesi Delta, and Zanzibar, among others.

Series one and two are arranged by publisher name and filed chronologically thereafter. Series 3 is arranged alphabetically by expedition leader name, and series 4 is organized by accession number.

Map-case 1

Series 1 includes 51 pages of engravings that were published in the *Illustrated London News* between August 23, 1851 to December 14, 1901. Many of the engravings are part of the "Dr. Livingstone" or "Mr. Stanley" series. Ships, animals, domestic scenes, maps, and battles are frequently illustrated, as are the Abyssinian, Griquas, Khoikoi, Ndebele, and Zulu peoples. Locations depicted include the Abyssinia, Annesley Bay, Dahomey, Hadoda Pass, Hamhamo Spring, Keiskamma Gorge, Mount Kilimanjaro, Kongone River, Lake Tanganyika, Limpopo River, Matabili [now Zimbabwe], Morocco, Nigeria, Red Sea, Sierra Leone, Somalia, South Africa, Tekonda Pass, Umizimkulu Waterfall, Zambesi Delta, and Zanzibar, among others.

Arranged in chronological order.

Items 43-45 contain engravings on both sides of the pages. One side is listed as side A, the other side B. For example, images 43-A and 43-B are on the same piece of paper, but one engraving is on the front, the other on the back.
