Film collection contains 34 travel films from around the world made by Thayer Soule, some of which were made with associates, that he used in presenting travel lectures around the country from 1935 to 1995. He was an associate with Burton Holmes, dean of travel lecturers, from 1946 to 1958.

Collection also includes still photographs, publicity materials and scripts and audio tape recordings of the accompanying lectures for some of the films.

Please note that the contents of the collection and the language and terminology used reflect the context and culture of the time of its creation. As an historical document, its contents may be at odds with contemporary views and terminology and considered offensive today. The information within this collection does not reflect the views of the Smithsonian Institution or Anthropology Archives, but is available in its original form to facilitate research.

Notes: Edited film begins in New York City and documents travel to the following locales: Azores Islands, Portugal (Lisbon, Sintra, and Estoria), Turkey (Istanbul and Buyukada), Syria (Damascus), Lebanon (countryside), India (New Delhi and Delhi), Siam (Bangkok), Hong Kong, and Japan (countryside, Kyoto, and Nara). Film also includes brief views of Wake Island, Hawaii; San Francisco; and New York City at night. Scenes include city and country street activities, bazaars (markets), historical and archeological sites, architecture, resorts, and local arts and crafts.

Scenes include castles (Inverlochy, Balmoral, Loch Ness); bowling; sheep shearing; Sussex handicrafts (musical instruments, bookbinding, and stained glass); London including "changing of the guard," the Tower of London, Tower Bridge, Antique Hypermarket, Portobello Road, Trafalgar Square, Regent Canal, and St. James Park; Morris dancers; Roman ruins; making of Rolls Royce cars and Wedgwood pottery; Edinburgh including Edinburgh Castle, Princess Street, and Holyrood Palace; sheep dog trials; laying pipes for North Sea oil operations; and Highland games.

2 Film reels (80 minutes; color silent; 2,893 feet; 16mm)

Notes: Edited film documents travel in Mexico. Locales shown include Monterrey (Huasteca Canyon, Chipinque Mesa, and Horsetail Falls); Zimapan; Hacienda San Miguel Regla; Teotihuacan; Mexico City (Anthropology Museum, Paseo de la Reforma, *zocalo*, and National Cathedral); Popocatepetl; Cuernavaca (Diego Rivera murals and Borda Gardens); Acapulco; Xochimilco; Taxco; Fortin de las Flores; San Miguel de Allende; Patzcuaro Lake; and island of Janitzio. Scenes include silver and other metal work of Taxco, making serapes, golden lacquer of Patzcuaro, reed baskets of Huihuatzio, devil carvers of Tocuaro, and copper workers of Santa Clara del Cobre.

Notes: Edited film documents travel through Japan. Locales filmed include Tokyo (Imperial Palace; Palace Hotel; Ginza department stores; kabuki theatre; sports including sumo, judo, skating, bowling, and basketball; Buddha of Kamakura; Hakone National Park; Shinkansen; and Tokyo's "bullet trains"); Okitsu; Nagoya; Gifu; Kyoto (Imperial Palace, Nijo Castle, Heian

Shrine, Golden Pavilion, and Kiyomizu Temple); Nara (Daibutsu Den, Great Buddha, and Kasuga Shrine); Inland Sea; Lake Chuzenji; and Kegon Falls. Other filming includes children at school, the Nogi family at home, *ikebana* (flower arranging), making of dolls and lanterns, evening on a barge with fireworks and dancing, cormorant fishing, *pachinko* parlor, manufacture of silk, screen painting, tea ceremony, *bunraku*, temple dance, festival, rice transplanting, fishing, and pearl diving.

Notes: Edited film documents travel around the Mediterranean. Locales shown include Naples, Pompeii, Sorrento, Amalfi, Ravello, Positano, and Capri, Italy; Athens, Corinth, Aegean Islands, Rhodes, Kos Island, Mykonos, and Santorin, Greece; and Cairo and Memphis, Egypt. Archeological sites include the Oracle of Delphi, Acropolis, and Parthenon in Greece and the pyramid of Cheops, the Sphinx, the step pyramid of Saqqara, the Great temple of Luxor, Colossi of Memnon, the temple of Queen Hatshepsut, the tomb of Tut-Ankh-Amen in the Valley of the Kings, the temple of Karnak, and the pyramids of Giza in Egypt. Also shown are making cameos in Naples, Italy, handicrafts of Greece including embroidery, and the Egyptian museum and Khan-El-Kahili bazaar in Cairo.

Mexico, Wonderful Mexico, 1975

Film reels (86 minutes; color silent; 3,089 feet; 16mm)

Notes: Edited film documents travel in Mexico. Film includes a brief history of Mexico and scenes of modern day Mexico. Locales shown include Mexico City and the Museum of Anthropology and numerous pre-Columbian archeological sites including Olmec ruins in the state of Tabasco, the pyramid of Tajin, Palenque, Chichen Itza, Uxmal, Teotihuacan, Monte Alban, and Mitla. Other locales include Merida, Cozumel, Acapulco, Xochimilco, Puebla, Taxco, Guadalajara, Puerto Vallarta, Mazatlan, Michoacan, Patzcuaro, Oaxaca, Zinacantan Village, and Chamula. Scenes include a Volkswagon plant, Puebla tile making, Taxco silver, lacquer ware, weaving, markets, and making cutlery.

Rainbow Lands of Central America, 1958

2 Film reels (91 minutes; color silent; 3,288 feet; 16mm)

Notes: Edited film documents travel through Panama, Costa Rica, El Salvador, and Guatemala. Locales in Panama include the canal and Canal Zone, Panama City, and the interior via the Chagres River. Locales and scenes in Costa Rica include agriculture at Coto Research Station, sawmill in a forest, San Jose, and handicrafts. Locales and scenes in El Salvador include educational efforts including the Santa Cecilia Trade School and new agricultural programs, cooperative stores, handicrafts, and Crater lakes and Izalco volcano. Locales in Guatemala include Guatemala City, a restored Antigua, the Mayan ruin of Tikal, a United Fruit plantation, mountainside farms on the way to Lake Atitlan, and the Chichicastenango market.

Film includes scenes of Caracas, Venezuela and surrounding area; Angel Falls; aerial views of the Andes including the volcano Chimboraza; Quito, Ecuador including influence of oil production and the Indian artist and sculptor, Oswaldo Quayasamin; the equator; Pan American highway; Otavalo Indian country; Indian market; Valley of the Volcanoes; Cuenca, Ecuador including market day and making and selling of Panama hats; Gualaceo Village, Ecuador including pottery market, furniture making, dying of fabric, embroidering, jewelry making, and decorating ceramics; Cuzco, Peru; Incan fortress of Sacsahuaman; Village of Pisac and Iquitos, Peru; Yagua Indians; and Punta Arenas, Chile.

Notes: Edited film documents travel in the American Southwest. Film focuses on places of interest including Las Vegas, Boulder, Painted Desert, Kingman, the Petrified Forest, and the Grand Canyon. Extensive footage is given to the Grand Canyon and Boulder in particular. Includes footage of city scenes, landscape panoramas, methods of travel, and tourist activities. Film is edited to include older black and white footage used to explain history of the area.
