Footage documenting celebrations at locations on and off the Pine Ridge and Rosebud reservations. Included are scenes of scenes of Frontier Days in Cheyenne, Wyoming, a parade through town, wagon races, encampment, horse riding of various sorts. Footage also shows poritons of a Sun Dance ceremony and an Alowanpi, or making Hunka ceremony.

Briefly documents the stelae at Quirigua, a Classic Maya archaeological site, along the Montagua River.
