The papers of Kracke's father, Edward A. Kracke, Jr., a professor of East Asian studies at the University of Chicago, are held at the University's Special Collections Research Center.

Processing Information

The Waud H. Kracke papers arrived at the National Anthropological Archives in boxes organized and labeled by Kracke's former graduate assistant, Dylan T. Lott. The archivist created series and sub-series based on this original arrangement of the materials.

The archivist retained Kracke's own labels for folders and items, where the original text was evident and legible. Illegible labels and labels not in English have been photocopied and placed in their corresponding locations in the collection. Documents containing student grades have been removed and destroyed. In Sub-series 6.7: Writings by others, only the material that was rare, annotated, or otherwise of enduring archival value was retained.

Biographical Note

Waud Hocking Kracke was an anthropologist who studied and advocated for the Parintintin (Kagwahiv) people of the Brazilian Amazon.

Born to Edward and Joan (nee Hocking) in Beijing, China in 1939, Kracke earned a bachelor's degree in history and science from Harvard College (1961) before transitioning to graduate studies in anthropology at the University of Chicago. He earned his master's degree in 1966 before being awarded his Ph.D. in 1973. In 1975 he was awarded a certificate from the Chicago Institute for Psychoanalysis in their research training program in psychoanalysis. Kracke began working as an instructor in the Department of Anthropology at the University of Illinois at Chicago Circle (UICC) in 1970. Though he would take visiting positions at Bennington College in Vermont (1982) and the Universidade de Brasília (1983), he continued teaching at UICC (which became the University of Illinois at Chicago, or UIC, in 1982) for the entirety of his professional career, earning tenure in 1990.

Kracke's doctoral dissertation, "Emotions and Personality in Parintintin Politics: A Study of Political Structure and Commotive Leadership in an Amazon Indian Tribe" (1973), became his first and only solo-authored book: *Force and Persuasion: Leadership in an Amazonian Society*, published by the University of Chicago Press in 1978. Kracke authored and collaborated on over 40 articles and encyclopedia entries focusing not only on the Parintintin, but on the subjects of anthropology and psychoanalysis. He was the recipient of two Fulbright awards, as well as the Boyer Prize for Contributions to Psychoanalytic Anthropology.

Following his doctoral fieldwork from 1967-1968, Kracke returned to Brazil and to the Parintintin at least once in every decade until his death. In 1985, he helped in the process of demarcating the Área (Terra) Indígena Parintintin on behalf of the Fundação Nacional do Índio (FUNAI). In 2007, he donated his artifact collections as well as copies (digital and physical) of his archival materials to the Museu do Índio in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil, with the express wish of providing easy access for the Parintintin and other Tupí peoples.

Kracke was married twice; first, to Laura Huysen Kracke (who, along with their son, Peter, accompanied him on several field trips to Brazil) and, later, to Brazilian Lúcia Villela Minnerly. He died on December 31, 2013 at his home in Hyde Park, Illinois.

Scope and Contents

The Waud H. Kracke papers, 1959-2013, document the research and professional accomplishments of social-psychoanalytical anthropologist Waud Kracke. Kracke studied the Parintintin (Kagwahiv) Indians of the Amazon as well as related Tupí indigenous cultures. He taught at the University of Illinois at Chicago (until 1982, the University of Illinois at Chicago Circle) for his entire professional career, with visiting stints at Bennington College in Vermont and the Universidade de Brasília in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil. Kracke contributed heavily to the anthropological literature on emotions, dream interpretation, myths, and psychoanalytic anthropology. His dissertation became the anthropological classic *Force and Persuasion: Leadership in an Amazonian Society*. In 1985, he worked to help research and demarcate the Área Indígena Parintintin for the Fundação Nacional do Índio (Brazil's National Indian Foundation, or FUNAI).

This collection documents Kracke's field research, writings, teaching, university service, and professional associations. It includes agendas and schedules; applications; bibliographies; correspondence; course files; CVs and resumes; departmental records; dissertations and theses; drafts and copies of presentations and manuscripts; field notes; forms and guidelines; handbooks; indigenous drawings, sketches, and paintings; interview transcripts; invitations; language texts and dictionaries; lecture notes; letters of recommendation; maps; meeting minutes; memoranda; photographic prints, negatives, and slides; published writings; reports; research proposals; reviews; student files; and syllabi.

Scope and Contents: Series 1 consists of Kracke's research material into the Parintintin and other indigenous cultures of South America. It documents his doctoral field work among the Parintintin in the late 1960s, as well as his return visits to Brazil in the 1970s, 1980s, and 1990s. This research largely documents Parintintin culture, society, cosmology, and language. Of note are interviews with the Parintintin informants Paulinho (a Parintintin chief) and Catarina (his wife), whose insights contributed substantially to Kracke's later published writings. Included in this series are research materials on the rights of Brazilian indigenous populations, with files documenting his research supporting the demarcation of the Área Indígena Parintintin for the Fundação Nacional do Índio (FUNAI) in the 1980s. Also included in this series is one box of material documenting Kracke's pre-doctoral field research in the wine-producing village of Chanzeaux in Maine-et-Loire, France in 1962 with Harvard undergraduate alumni and Professor Laurence Wylie.

The material in this series includes correspondence; field diaries; genealogies; interview transcripts; language texts and dictionaries; maps and charts; news articles and clippings; notes; photographic prints, negatives, slides, and digital images; reports (relatórios); and sketches, drawings, and paintings.

Arrangement: Series 1 is divided into the following 6 sub-series: (1.1) Field notes, 1966-1998, undated; (1.2) Paulinho, circa 1967-circa 1973, circa 1985-1990, 2005-2008; (1.3) Interviews and informants, circa 1967-circa 1989, 2010, undated; (1.4) Photographs, 1966-2002; (1.5) Artwork, 1967, circa 1986-circa 1990, 2000; (1.6) Indigenous rights and assorted research files, 1960-2010, undated; (1.7) Chanzeaux, circa 1962-circa 1973, circa 1990.

Subseries 1.1: Field notes, 1966-1998, undated

Scope and Contents: This sub-series documents Kracke's field trips to Brazil, from his doctoral fieldwork in the 1960s to his returning research visits in the 1970s, 1980s, and 1990s. Kracke organized his field notes by date and place, and occasionally by informant (though the bulk of field note interviews with specific informants can be found in sub-series (1.3): Interviews and informants). These field notes document Kracke's research into the Parintintin of the Amazon, as well as into nearby and associated indigenous groups.

The material in this sub-series largely takes three forms: notebooks (or field diaries), typewritten field notes, and photocopies of the diaries and typed notes. While the notebooks, typed pages, and photocopied pages often contain the same content, they were created and utilized for different purposes. Excerpts of field notes, as photocopies, are collected and contained under topical headings at the end of the sub-series.

Arrangement: The material in sub-series (1.1) is arranged chronologically. Undated material at the end of the sub-series is arranged alphabetically.

Subseries 1.2: Paulinho, circa 1967-circa 1973, circa 1985-1990, 2005-2008

Scope and Contents: This sub-series relates to the Parintintin informant Paulinho (alternately named Idjet, Ijet, Paulinho Neves or Paulinho Neves Parintintin). The material in this sub-series includes interviews and annotated interview notes; stories and myths; transcripts; and notebooks.

Paulinho was a chief of the Parintintin in the Ipixuna Valley and was crucial in mediating the relationship between the Parintintin and the SPI (Indian Protection Service, the precursor to FUNAI) for over 20 years. He provided Kracke with much of the latter's knowledge of Parintintin myth and cosmology. According to Kracke, "Paulinho became one of my best teachers in the study of Parintintin culture and society. And the drawings he made for me opened a vision of the Parintintin view of the universe" (Box 85, "An Amazonian World through Paulinho's Eye," Series 2: Writings). In 2004-2005, Kracke proposed a study and book on Paulinho entitled "An Amazonian World through Paulinho's Eye/O mundo Parintintin por Paulinho (Ijet)," which was never completed. This proposal, and the presentation built of this idea, provide valuable context for Kracke's relationship with the chief, storyteller, and artist (see Boxes 85 and 119).

The material in this sub-series overlaps with material in sub-series (1.3): Interviews and informants, but was kept separate by the archivist to reflect Kracke's own organization of these materials. Additional interviews with Paulinho can be found in that sub-series. Photographs, photocopies, and digital scans of Paulinho's drawings can be found in sub-series (1.5): Artwork.

Scope and Contents: This sub-series documents Kracke's interviews and discussions with various Parintintin informants during his field research trips of the 1960s, 1970s, and 1980s. The material consists of topical field notes centered around particular informants. Of note in this sub-series is the material related to Catarina/Caterina (the third wife of Parintintin chief Paulinho), which relates to Kracke's 1999 publication, "A Language of Dreaming: Dreams of an Amazonian Insomniac." Subseries 1.4: Photographs, 1966-2002

Scope and Contents: This sub-series consists of the photographs taken by Kracke during his various field and research trips to Brazil and other South American locations. The photographs document Parintintin and other Amazonian Indian societies, as well as archaeological sites and South American cities.

Many of the photographic slides in this sub-series related to the Parintintin people were digitized by the Museu do Índio in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil, as a part of their Projeto Memória e Imagens Indígenas. The original slides were returned to Kracke and are housed here, alongside copies of the digitized images on CDs. A letter detailing this content (with accompanying inventories of the digitized photographs) can be found at the beginning of the sub-series.

Arrangement: Sub-series (1.4) is arranged into the following 2 sections: chronological photographs, which are arranged chronologically and by reel number; and topical photographs, which are arranged

alphabetically under thematic labels created by Kracke. Inventories, box labels, and loose papers filed with slides can be found listed alongside their respective photographs. The majority of the chronological photographs have corresponding inventories created when slides were digitized by the Museu do Índio.

Scope and Contents: Series 2 consists of Kracke's published and unpublished articles, presentations, student (course) papers, dissertation, and book manuscript, mostly on the topics of psychoanalytic anthropology, linguistic anthropology, leadership, and emotion among the Parintintin (Kagwahiv) of Brazil. The material in this series includes drafts, proofs, revisions, and reprints, as well as outlines, notes, and correspondence.

The bulk of the material in this series relates to published and proposed book chapters, journal and magazine articles, and encyclopedia entries, as well as to papers presented at conferences, seminars, and symposia. This series also documents the writing, revision, and publication of Kracke's lone solo-authored book, *Force and Persuasion: Leadership in an Amazonian Society* (1978), which was drawn from his doctoral dissertation, "Emotions and Personality in Parintintin Politics: A Study of Political Structure and Commotive Leadership in an Amazon Indian Tribe" (1973).

Arrangement: Series 2 is divided into the following 2 sub-series: (2.1) Dissertation and *Force and Persuasion*, circa 1966-1981; (2.2) Articles, papers, drafts, and manuscripts, 1959-2012.

Subseries 2.1: Dissertation and *Force and Persuasion*, circa 1966-1981

Scope and Contents: This sub-series documents the creation of Kracke's doctoral dissertation (which he labeled his "thesis"), "Emotions and Personality in Parintintin Politics: A Study of Political Structure and Commotive Leadership in an Amazon Indian Tribe" (1973), and the resulting book, *Force and Persuasion: Leadership in an Amazonian Society* (1978). The bulk of the sub-series consists of photocopies of completed dissertation chapters as well as multiple sets of drafts of sections from both the dissertation and book. The sub-series also includes abstracts, correspondence, criticism and reviews, notes, outlines, a copy of Kracke's contract with the University of Chicago Press, and Kracke's dissertation proposal and grant application from the National Science Foundation.

Arrangement: The material in sub-series (2.1) is arranged in rough chronological order, with material relating to Kracke's dissertation preceding material relating to *Force and Persuasion*. Drafts are located at the end of the sub-series. The archivist made every attempt to ensure that different "sets" of manuscripts and chapter drafts were kept together.

Scope and Contents: Series 3 consists of professional and personal letters, postcards, and printed emails to and from Waud Kracke. It includes correspondence from Brazilian informants; graduate faculty advisors; journals and university presses; anthropology students seeking advice, bibliographic recommendations, or sponsorship for admission to the University of Illinois at Chicago; professional and alumni organizations; and friends and family of Kracke. The bulk of the material consists of correspondence with anthropological colleagues; as well as correspondence regarding Kracke's reviews of scholarly literature and his relationship with the journal *The Psychoanalytic Study of Society*.

Additional correspondence can be found scattered throughout the collection, attached to related material. The bulk of additional correspondence can be found in Series 6, attached to annotated and review copies of articles, book chapters, and conference papers sent to Kracke by his anthropological colleagues.

Arrangement: The majority of the correspondence is arranged alphabetically by individual correspondent or corresponding institution. Certain correspondence has been collected at the beginning of the series under the label "Assorted"; this correspondence has no readily-identifiable or -legible name attached. Kracke had organized some correspondence into topical folders labeled "Anthropology," "Dream research," "Political psychology," "Psychoanalytic anthropology," and "South America." These folders, along with one folder originally labeled "Recent," have been collected together under the label "Professional."

- Scope and Contents:** Series 4 consists of material relating to Kracke's responsibilities as a professor of anthropology. Throughout his professional life, Kracke taught courses related to anthropology, Latin American studies, and psychoanalysis at both American and Brazilian institutions (predominantly the University of Illinois at Chicago (UIC), Bennington College, the Field Museum, and the Universidade de Brasília). As a professor, Kracke also mentored undergraduate and graduate students and served as a professional resource throughout certain students' careers through such activities as writing letters of recommendation or providing advice and commentary on articles and research proposals.
- The material in this series includes course teaching materials such as syllabi, lecture notes, handouts, photographic slides, assignment prompts, exam questions, textbook and readings lists, forms, and notes; as well as masters' theses, doctoral dissertations, research proposals, essays, and correspondence from Kracke's mentored students.
- Arrangement:** Series 4 is divided into the following 2 sub-series: (4.1) Course files, 1966-2013; and (4.2) Student files, circa 1970-1999.

Subseries 4.1: Course files, 1966-2013

- Scope and Contents:** This sub-series contains material related to the teaching of courses in anthropology, Latin American studies, and psychoanalysis. The material includes syllabi, lecture notes, handouts, photographic slides, assignment prompts, exam questions, textbook and readings lists, forms, and notes.
- The bulk of the material is connected to specific classes at the University of Illinois at Chicago that Kracke taught over the course of several decades. Certain classes (among them "South American Indians" and "Brazil: A Multiethnic Society") carried multiple numbers and names between the 1970s and 2000s. Additional material also reflects teaching done in conjunction with the Field Museum in Chicago and at the Universidade de Brasília.
- Arrangement:** The material in sub-series (4.1) is arranged by course number, and chronologically therein. Material unconnected to specific courses is listed at the end of the sub-series.
