Summary:	Vivian E. Garrison was an applied medical anthropologist who researched the cultural understandings and community treatment structures surrounding mental illness and mental health care among low-income, minority, and migrant communities of the New York metropolitan area. The Vivian E. Garrison papers document this research and consist of clinical and case files; research policies and protocols; presentations and workshops notes; manuscripts and drafts; publications and working papers; correspondence; grant applications; administrative files; sound recordings and films; annotated scholarly literature; and personal biographical material.

Biographical Note

Vivian Eva Garrison, known as "Kelly" to friends and colleagues, was an applied medical anthropologist who researched the cultural understandings and community treatment structures surrounding mental illness and mental health care among low-income, minority, and migrant communities the New York metropolitan area. She worked predominantly with African American, Hispanic, and Caribbean migrant populations in the South Bronx and in Newark, New Jersey.

Garrison was born on August 28, 1933 in Butte, Montana. She earned a B.A. in Spanish and psychology from New York University in 1961 and a Ph.D. in anthropology from Columbia University in 1972. Her dissertation, *Social Networks, Social Change and Mental Health among Migrants in a New York City Slum*, was completed in 1971.

Garrison conducted her research under the purview of various federal and state grants to examine community mental health care. The majority of her research was completed at Lincoln Hospital in the Bronx, at the College/University of Medicine and Dentistry of New Jersey, and at Columbia University.

Throughout her career, Garrison acted as a consultant in matters of folk healing and community health care and published frequently on folk healing, *espiritismo*, psychiatry, and psychiatric methodology. She taught intermittently, including teaching one semester of Margaret Mead's "Problems and Methods in Anthropology" course at Columbia University (1979). She also contributed to the President's Commission on Mental Health in 1977-1978.

Garrison married anthropologist Conrad M. Arensberg in 1973 and died in April 2013 at the age of 79.

Scope and Contents

The papers of Vivian E. Garrison, circa 1930-2009 (bulk 1960-1993) document her work as an applied medical anthropologist in the New York metropolitan area. Garrison studied and published on the cultural understandings and community treatment structures surrounding mental illness and mental health care among low-income, minority, and migrant communities. The collection includes clinical and case files, sound recordings, and films; research policies and protocols; presentations and workshop notes and recordings; manuscripts and drafts; publications and working papers; correspondence; grant applications; administrative files; annotated scholarly literature (reprints and books); and personal biographical material.

The bulk of material in the collection relates to Garrison's research under and administration of different research grants focusing on community mental health care in the greater New York City area. As a research scientist at the Lincoln Hospital Mental Health Services (LHMHS), Garrison undertook anthropological research under the National Institute of Mental Health (NIMH) grant, "Study of Neighborhood Centers and Mental Health Aides" (1965-1969). The research completed at LHMHS was used in her dissertation (1971). Garrison continued her studies of the South Bronx populations at the Columbia-Bronx Research Center as principal investigator under the NIMH grant, "Folk Healers and Community Mental Health Programming" (1972-1975). She built upon that research as the director and principal investigator of the U.S. Public Health Grant "Inner-City Support Systems" (ICSS) from 1976-1982, run through the College (later University) of Medicine and Dentistry of New Jersey (C/UMDNJ). Within the Resource Center for Multicultural Care and Prevention (RCMCP) at UMDNJ (born out of the ICSS program), Garrison administered the NIMH grant "Community Support Systems of Haitian Immigrants," (CSSHI) which transferred to Columbia University in 1984. Garrison's research under these and other grants was typically undertaken in concert with anthropological colleagues, community consultants, and medical professionals. The materials in this collection reflect the collaborative nature of this research process, as well as Garrison's administrative role at the ICSS project at UMDNJ. Some research notes, case files, and manuscript drafts of colleagues and contributors are present in this collection.

The collection also contains personal biographical, medical, and historical material documenting the lives of Vivian Garrison and her husband, anthropologist Conrad M. Arensberg. Much of this material relates to Arensberg's medical history and care in the last years of his life, as meticulously recorded and analyzed by Garrison. Personal material in the collection also relates to the preservation and destruction of her historic home in Rumson, New Jersey (the Morris-Salter-Hartshorn-Tredwell House).

Scope and Contents: Series 1 consists of material documenting Garrison's research into the mental health care and population characteristics of Puerto Rican and African American communities of the South Bronx with Yeshiva University Albert Einstein College of Medicine Lincoln Hospital Mental Health Services (LHMHS). The series includes administrative files, coding cards and codebooks, community directories, data and tabulations, field notes, grant applications, lists, maps, reports, and sound recordings.

Garrison served in the Research Division at LHMHS under the National Institute of Mental Health (NIMH) grant, "Study of Neighborhood Centers and Mental Health Aides." Of note in this series are the lists and directories mapping the businesses and religious landscape of the South Bronx, as well as material documenting the 1968-1969 civil rights "crisis" at Lincoln Hospital.

While gathered during her time at LHMHS, some of the data in this series was processed at a later date. Material in this series relates to Garrison's doctoral dissertation, *Social Networks, Social Change and Mental Health Among Migrants in a New York City Slum* (Columbia University, 1971). Related material can be found in Series 2: Columbia University Bronx Research Center. Additional material related to publications made from LHMHS-gathered data can be found in Series 5: Publications, manuscripts, and associated research files.

Arrangement: Series 1 is arranged into 4 sub-series: (1.1) Research files, data, and tabulations, circa 1960-1972; (1.2) Medical questionnaires, 1967-1969; (1.3) Sound recordings, 1967; and (1.4) Administrative files, circa 1965-1973.

Scope and Contents: Series 2 consists of material documenting Garrison's research into the mental health care and folk healing practices of Puerto Rican and African American communities of the South Bronx with Columbia University. Scope and Contents: Series 3 contains material documenting Garrison's research into the community health practices of low-income and minority communities of the greater New York City area (predominantly Newark, New Jersey), as well as her implementation of culturally sensitive clinical practice and health care training with the College/University of Medicine and Dentistry of New Jersey (C/UMDNJ). This series includes case files and clinical interviews; clinical evaluation instruments, including interview and observation schedules; data cards; tables and tabulations; sound and video recordings of clinical interviews with patients and healers; correspondence; conference notes; drafts and publications; grant applications; reports; photographic slide presentations; sound and video recordings of workshops, presentations, and staff meetings; workshop scripts and handouts; training manuals; and notes.

Garrison served as the Principal Investigator of the U.S. Public Health Grant "Inner-City Support Systems" (ICSS) at UMDNJ. Much of the material in this series is administrative, documenting the implementation of research done at ICSS (through workshops, presentations, and publications) and the administration of the grant (through applications, reports, and financial documents).

Of note in the series are materials related to "Bumi" (in sub-series (3.5)). These materials document a particular training module created by ICSS staff surrounding the implementation of culturally-sensitive clinical healing practices. Also of note is sub-series (3.6) Working papers and publications, circa 1975-1989, 2006. This sub-series documents both internal reports and external publications created by ICSS staff. It includes correspondence, drafts, and proofs ("slugs") of a series of ICSS-specific papers published in the journal *Psychiatric Annals*. This sub-series also contains detailed definitions of "support systems" and the ICSS project.

Scope and Contents: Series 4 consists of material documenting Garrison's research into the community health practices of the Haitian population of the greater New York City area (predominantly New York City and Newark, New Jersey) with the College/University of Medicine and Dentistry of New Jersey (C/UMDNJ) and Columbia University (CU). The series includes administrative files, case vignettes, correspondence, data and tabulations, field notes, financial documents, forms, grant applications, linguistic glossaries, presentations and workshop notes, publications, research policies and protocols, surveys, and working papers.

Garrison worked as the Principal Director administering the National Institute of Mental Health (NIMH) grant, "Community Support Systems of Haitian Immigrants" (referred to throughout her records variously as "Haitian grant," "Haitian project," and "CSSHI"). The grant was first awarded to CMDNJ under Garrison's oversight of the Inner-City Support Systems Project. The project director of the grant at UMDNJ was Linda Gutwirth, and many of the materials in this series were created or compiled by her. The CSSHI grant was transferred to Columbia University in 1984. Of note in this series are the case study vignettes, in both draft and final forms, that discuss the experience of various patients and healers as well as Haitian Vodou (Vodon) practices.

Related material can be found in Series 3: Inner-City Support Systems Project. Additional material related to publications made from CSSHI-gathered data can be found in Series 5: Publications, manuscripts, and associated research files.

Scope and Contents: Series 6 consists of material documenting the presentations, conferences, and workshops Garrison attended, arranged, or participated in. The series includes correspondence; agendas and programs; brochures; draft presentations; annotated papers; handouts; and travel memoranda.

Garrison attended regional, national, and international conferences across a variety of disciplines including mental health care, psychiatry, and psychoanalysis, as well as anthropology and cultural studies. She frequently presented her research related to community-based support systems in workshops or seminar presentations at universities, hospitals, and research or community centers in the greater New York City area. Of note in this series are the materials related to a presentation at the National Institute of Mental Health Staff College in December 1980, "Natural Support Systems in Minority Communities." Much of the material in this series relates explicitly to research completed under the Inner-City Support Systems (ICSS) grant at the College/University of Medicine and Dentistry of New Jersey. However (as with her manuscripts and publications), Garrison frequently referenced earlier Bronx-based research alongside her ICSS data.

Scope and Contents: Series 8 consists of personal biographical, medical, and historical material documenting Vivian Garrison and Conrad Arensberg's lives. It includes personal Garrison records, including a copy of her birth certificate; driver's license; marriage certificate and license; passports; Garrison family genealogy; and notes, reflections, and medical records from her time spent in a psychiatric hospital. The series also includes correspondence with friends and family, the bulk of which is with Conrad Arensberg's three adult children (Cornel, Emily, and Meg/Margaret) and grandchildren.

Most of the material in this series documents Arensberg's life and death through records kept and curated by Garrison. The series contains Garrison's "archive" of personal Arensberg materials, including his birth certificate and passports; bibliographies; class directories; correspondence; obituaries and memorials; and personal biographies created by close family and friends. The bulk of the Conrad Arensberg material relates to his medical history, including medical records; correspondence with physicians, organizations, and colleagues; care plans; notes; and handwritten logs kept by Garrison and by Arensberg's various nurses and aides. Garrison kept meticulous records regarding her husband's medical condition following a traumatic car accident in December 1991, when Arensberg was 81. The records document Arensberg's rehabilitation from his accident, as well as his decline in the last years of his life. The records also document Garrison's reflections as a wife, caregiver, and medically-trained anthropologist. Arensberg's official medical records, as well as Garrison's correspondence with her husband's physicians, have been retained to provide context for Garrison's notes and analysis.

The series also contains correspondence, notes, tests and reports, newspaper clippings, and newsletters related to Garrison and Arensberg's historic home in Rumson, New Jersey: the Morris-Salter-Hartshorn-Tredwell House, commonly referred to as the Tredwell House.

In notes and labels, Garrison often abbreviated her husband's name to "CMA."
