# **Biographical Note**

James Mooney (1861-1921) was a self-taught ethnologist. He was employed by the Bureau of American Ethnology from 1885 until his death. In this capacity, he worked extensively among the Cherokee and Kiowa. Among the Kiowa his studies focused on pictorial calendars, the peyote religion, and heraldry, the term he used to refer to the

designs on shields and painted tipis. In the course of his study of Kiowa and Cheyenne heraldry, he commissioned illustrations of shield and tipi designs, as well as miniature shields and tipis.

## **Scope and Contents**

The collection consists of sixty-five (65) hand-colored photographs of Kiowa shields and tipis. The photographs were made by James Mooney to illustrate an article on Kiowa helaldry. The article was not published. Many of the photographs are not captioned; some are marked with the tipi name, and/or the owner's name, and/or USNM catalog numbers.

Please note that the contents of the collection and the language and terminology used reflect the context and culture of the time of its creation. As an historical document, its contents may be at odds with contemporary views and terminology and considered offensive today. The information within this collection does not reflect the views of the Smithsonian Institution or National Anthropological Archives, but is available in its original form to facilitate research.
