Original is in hand of same scribe as Manuscript Letter Signed, Wowodsky to Gibbs, 21/5 March, 1858 and Manuscript Letter Signed, Furuhjelm to Gibbs, 10/22 November, 1959, transmitting vocabularies (NAA file Number 371). It was evidently transmitted with the latter. Gibbs' copy is marked, "Furuhjelm," but the original is marked in J.N.B. Hewitt's hand, "Gov. Wowodsky," an evident error. Copy of the above by George Gibbs. No date. Manuscript document. 2 pages.
