Scope and Contents

Photos are of Potawatomi (Prairie Band) and a few Sauk and Fox Indians, taken at various dates from the 1880's to 1957. Feder's captions, transcribed from negative jackets, are with prints in album. Most of the persons in the photographs are identified by name. Feder evidently secured some of the identification from persons living on the Potawatomi Reservation. See letter of Feder to M. C.
