Administrative Information

Provenance

The drawings were collected by Ludwig Kumlien on the Howgate Polar Expedition and most likely deposited in the United States National Museum (USNM) along with other artifacts from the Expedition. There are no USNM accession or catalog numbers associated with the drawings. The drawings were transferred from the object collections of the Department of Anthropology to the National Anthropological Archives in 1969.

Processing Information

The drawings in this collection were originally cataloged by the National Anthropological Archives in two lots as "Drawings, Eskimo--Land and sea animals, inscribed "Wrichatau, a Cumberland Island Eskimo" and "Drawings, Eskimo--Eskimo activities, insects, animals, and a stone lamp, by Eskimo artists from Cumberland Island." In 2023, all drawings collected by Kumlien were consolidated into a single collection. The drawings were arranged chronologically.

Biographical Note

Aaron Ludwig Kumlien (1853–1902) was an American ornithologist. He was a member of the Howgate Polar Expedition (1877-1878) and collected ethnological, zoological, botanical, and other specimens for the United States National Museum.

Scope and Contents

The collection consists of eleven (11) drawings by Inuit artists collected by Ludwig Kumlien on the Howgate Polar Expedition. The drawings depict animals and daily activities, including hunting.

Please note that the contents of the collection and the language and terminology used reflect the context and culture of the time of its creation. As an historical document, its contents may be at odds with contemporary views and terminology and considered offensive today. The information within this collection does not reflect the views of the Smithsonian Institution or National Anthropological Archives, but is available in its original form to facilitate research.
