These include portraits of BAE personnel and others, including one photograph of men at the Smithsonian Castle and an image possibly showing De Lancey Gill in his office. An additional set of

photographs show an archeological expedition in the American Southwest, possibly involving William Boone Douglass. Depicted individuals include De Lancey Gill, William Henry Holmes, and James Mooney. Many of the portraits may have been made by Gill. The prints in the collection were likely made by the Smithsonian Office of Printing and Photographic Services from the negatives in the collection.
