Raised in Arizona, he received his BFA from Arizona State University and MFA from the University of New Mexico. He received a fellowship for participation in the Woodland Algonquians of Wisconsin project.

Photographs depicting participants in a "live-in" course entitled "Woodland Algonquians of Wisconsin," offered by the University of Wisconsin, Milwaukee in July 1976. Most of the images show participants

constructing a birch-bark wigwam. Participants included members of the Chippewa, Menominee, and Potawatomi tribes.
