The collection consists largely of images of Fox Indians of Tama, Iowa, including portraits of families, delegates, and dancers, as well as images of food preparation and a wigwam. It also includes images of a Taos woman baking and portraits of Crow, Dakota, Navajo, and Winnebago Indians, including Chief Spotted Tail, Chief Crazy Horse, artist Max Big Man, and Chief White Cloud.
