It consists mainly of manuals and charts, including: a number of map books containing maps of the southeastern United States, U.S. Army pilot checklists for Hughes TH-55A, Beech U-21A Ute, Boeing-Vertol CH-47A Chinook, and Bell OH-58A Kiowa, material from Eastern Air Lines, and McDonnell Douglas DC-10 technical information.
