Biographical / Historical

In 1931, at the end of Charles and Anne Morrow Lindberghs' famous flight to the Far East in their Lockheed Sirius *Tingmissartog*, their aircraft was damaged, and they sailed from Yokohama, Japan to Vancouver, Canada aboard the steamship SS *President Jefferson* to arrive in time for Anne's father's funeral. All passengers were required to fill out forms providing basic demographic and contact information which were kept by the purser.

Scope and Contents

This collection consists of two forms completed and signed by Charles A. and Anne Morrow Lindbergh, giving the family name, given name, age, birth date and place, ports of embarkation and destination, address, gender, ethnicity, marital status, and occupation. The collection also contains a card bearing what appears to be an auction lot description for the sale of the forms.
