Summary:	A New York bookseller, Warshaw assembled this collection over nearly fifty years. The Subject Categories subseries is divided into 470 subject categories based on those created by Mr. Warshaw. #### Acquisition Information

Knitting is a portion of the Business Ephemera Series of the Warshaw Collection of Business Americana, Accession AC0060 purchased from Isadore Warshaw in 1967. Warshaw continued to accumulate similar material until his death, which was donated in 1971 by his widow, Augusta. For a period after acquisition, related materials from other sources (of mixed provenance) were added to the collection so there may be content produced or published after Warshaw's death in 1969. This practice has since ceased.

This material consists primarily of manuals, knitting instructions, bills/receipts, and handbooks from manufacturers and dealers of yarn and knitting machines. Instruction manuals include directions for knitting and crocheting sweaters, hats, slippers, purses, underwear, and afghans. The material dates from 1854-1912 but the bulk is late nineteenth century,

Materials are organized by name of company. There are four folders of material arranged by type: knitting instructions, general images, related articles, and related books.
