Biographical / Historical

Tad Hershorn, archivist at Rutgers University's Institute of Jazz Studies, has written about and photographed jazz since the late 1960s. Among his publications are three books including Ella Fitzgerald Companion (2004), Verve: Norman Granz, The Conscience Of Jazz (2006), and Norman Granz: The Man Who Used Jazz for Justice (2011).

Scope and Contents

Collection consists of material relating to jazz including photographs and printed material of jazz performers. There are some newspaper clippings relating to jazz promoter Norman Granz the creator and producer of the jazz concert series Jazz at the Philharmonic. A typescript history of jazz at the Philharmonic is also found among these materials. Materials are arranged in chronological order.
