Biographical / Historical

The Zembo Shrine of Harrisburg was constituted on October 12, 1904, 32 years after the Ancient Arabic Order of the Nobles of the Mystic Shrine was established. Their activities emphasized work with children's hospitals.

Scope and Contents

An album of photographs documenting the activities of the members of the Zembo Shrine of Harrisburg, Pennsylvania. The album includes images of members involved in charitable activities for children from Shriners' Hospitals; of members engaged in ritual activities or participating in public events such as parades; and of members in regalia.
