Ernest Weidhaas (1888-1974) was a gem and mineral collector and prominent member of the New York Mineralogical Society.

This collection contains eight stereocards collected by Ernest Weidhaas. The images depict dwellings, hieroglyphs, and Native Americans from Ute, Shoshone, and Ojibwa communities. Most of the photographs were taken during the construction of railroads. Catalog numbers P19883, P19886-P19889, and P19891-P19893.
