## **Biographical / Historical**

Edwin Carleton (E.C.) MacDowell (1887-1973) was a geneticist specializing in experimental evolution. He graduated from Swarthmore College in 1909 and completed his PHD in Zoology from Harvard in 1913. He taught zoology at Dartmouth and biology at Yale before starting at the Carnegie Institution of Washington, where he studied hereditary factors for leukemia and the influence of alcohol on prenatal mortality. After World War I, he was a Quaker relief worker in France with the American Friends Reconstruction Unit. MacDowell also served as secretary of the Long Island Biological Association.

## **Scope and Contents**

This collection contains 85 black and white gelatin prints and 20 black and white photograph postcards ranging in size from 1.5x2 inches to 3x5 inches. The photographer is unknown, but they were collected by Dr. E.C. MacDowell during an archaeological expedition to Chichen Itza and Uxmal conducted by the Carnegie Institution of Washington in 1929. Some of the photographs are repeats.
