Biographical / Historical

Master Sergeant Chuck Boers joined the US Army in 1982 and has been a member of the 55th Signal Company (Combat Camera Unit) since 1993. While on leave from his regular duties, he documented the Al Taqaddum Inter-Tribal Powwow, September 17-18, 2004, in Al Taqaddum, Iraq, held by the U.S. Army's 120th Engineer Combat Battalion (headquartered in Okmulgee, Oklahoma). These digital images were donated to NMAI by Battalion members and their chaplain, Sergeant Debra K. Mooney (Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma), in 2005.

Scope and Contents

This collection contains 6 digital photographs depicting the Inter-Tribal Powwow held in Al Taqaddum, Iraq on September 17-18, 2004 by the U.S. Army's 120th Engineer Combat Battalion (headquartered in Okmulgee, Oklahoma). The photographs were shot by Master Sergeant Chuck Boers.

The images include depictions a a game of stickball in Camp Taqaddum, Iraq; a drum circle; portraits of Native soldiers in dress regalia; a tamahawk throwing contest; a portrait of the U.S. Army's 120th Engineer Combat Battalion posing with a flag of the Cherokee tribe of Oklahoma; and a portrait of two soldiers [Muscogee (Creek)] posing with a flag of the Muscogee (Creek) Nation.
