## Descriptive Entry

This accession consists of records documenting the external and internal on-line presence of the Smithsonian Environmental Research Center (SERC). The files are divided into three sets. The first set consists of SERC's public website as of August 2004, including some files that were never made public. These files were captured immediately before a redesigned website was launched. The second set consists of a parallel website, also as of August 2004, that was used for testing purposes prior to deployment to the public website. The third set consists of SERC's intranet as of June 28, 2007.

The SERC public website includes information and photographs related to its mission, research, facilities, public programs, and staff. The website also includes some publications, educational games, and activity guides for teachers.

The SERC intranet includes general policies, safety information, technical support documents, committee meeting minutes, website statistics, staff photographs, and an electronic bulletin board. Materials are in electronic format.
