## Descriptive Entry

This accession consists of three websites and one blog maintained by the National Museum of American History.

The main National Museum of American History website, crawled on October 23, 2013, includes information about visiting, exhibitions, departments, staff, donating, internships, fellowships, and volunteering. It also includes online exhibitions.

*O Say Can You See?*, crawled on October 23, 2013, is the National Museum of American History's blog. The blog takes readers behind the scenes at the museum, sharing insights and information about its exhibitions, events, collections, research projects, and more. The first entry was posted in July 2008.

The *History Wired: A Few of Our Favorite Things* website, crawled November 7, 2013, provides a virtual tour of selected collection objects, many of which are not on public display. Due to technical issues, the site's interactive features may not function properly, but a text-only version is available from the bottom of the main page.

The Science Service website, crawled November 4, 2013, allows browsing and searching of online historical images related to electricity from the Science Service collections.
