Descriptive Entry

This accession consists of seven Vine accounts maintained by various units throughout the Smithsonian Institution as they existed in February 2016. Vine is a platform for sharing continuously looping videos of up to 6 seconds long. Vine videos are generally created using a mobile application and can be uploaded to the Vine website or, more commonly, shared via Twitter (which owns Vine) and other social media platforms. This accession includes captures of accounts on the website which may or may not represent all of the Vine videos created by a unit. Vine is commonly used by Smithsonian units to create promotional videos or demonstrate professional practices. Materials are in electronic format.
