Eklund, curator of chemistry, which document planning, development and production activities for the exhibitions "Henry Wurtz (1828-1910): An American Chemist," "Aspects of Art and Science," "Ceramics as Historical Evidence," and the Hall of American Science at the National Museum of American History, and when the museum was known as the National Museum of History and Technology. Also represented in these records are curators Susan Faye Cannon and Bernard S. Finn.
