## **Descriptive Entry**

This accession consists of tweets using the hashtag "#ANationsStory." The hashtag is used by the National Museum of African American History and Culture to call attention to a variety of social media campaigns. It is also often used by visitors to the museum. Twitter is a microblogging platform and its posts are known as "tweets." Approximately 17,592 tweets using this hashtag were exported into a spreadsheet between August 7, 2019, and June 19, 2020. Due to technical issues, some tweets may be truncated. In addition, the Twitter search results for "#ANationsStory" were crawled on August 16, 2019. Materials are in electronic format.
