This accession consists of a website and a blog maintained by the Biodiversity Heritage Library Consortium (BHL). BHL is a consortium of major natural history, botanical, and research libraries that cooperate to digitize and make accessible the literature of biodiversity held in their collections as a part of a global "biodiversity commons."

The "About the Biodiversity Heritage Library" website was crawled on April 7, 2020. It provides information about the consortium and its tools, services, and projects. Collections information is not stored on this website.

The BHL blog, which originally launched in April 2007, was crawled on March 16, 2020. It includes news and notes about collections, projects, and tools.
