This accession consists of a website and a data repository maintained by the Smithsonian Institution Scholarly Press. The Scholarly Press publishes research by Smithsonian Institution scholars in many fields as well as research closely related to Smithsonian Institution collections.

The website, crawled on May 5, 2020, includes information about publications and for authors.

The data repository, crawled on March 27, 2020, contains the Scholarly Press's open access content and allows the public to freely download these publications. The repository is hosted within the Smithsonian Institution's instance of Figshare. Due to technical issues, some functionality of the repository does not behave as expected in this accession and full text of the publications may not be downloadable.
