Historical Note

In 1982, the Kellogg Foundation provided a three-year grant to the Smithsonian Institution's Office of Museum Programs (OMP) and Resident Associates Program (RAP) "to expand the educational influence of museums." The Kellogg Project, designed to encourage greater recognition and utilization of the education potential of museums, sponsored colloquia, workshops, seminars, residencies, and videotapes for museum professionals throughout the United States. After receiving a three-year extension, the Project was completed in 1988.
