## Historical Note

In 1983 the Wilson Center began to produce its own series of radio broadcasts called *Radio Dialogue*. Occasionally, these programs were also broadcast by National Public Radio or Radio Smithsonian. Deputy Director Prosser Gifford was the moderator, aided by Eugenie Beth Skarstrom, who served as Radio Coordinator, 1984-1988. George Liston Seay became moderator of the *Radio Dialogue* series in 1988. He served in this position, 1988-1990, and as Director 1990- , when the program became known simply as *Dialogue*.

## Descriptive Entry

This record unit consists of audiotapes and transcripts from *Radio Dialogue* and *Dialogue* between the dates 27 October 1989 and 30 November 1990. Some of these tapes were also broadcast on National Public Radio.
